

## The 2024 California Processing Tomato Harvest Is Underway


The 2024 California processed tomato deliveries are steadily increasing. For week three (ending July 20<sup>th</sup>) PTAB is projecting 556,875 tons to be delivered and for the fourth week (ending July 27<sup>th</sup>) PTAB is estimating 856,467 tons to be delivered. This would bring the year-to-date total to an estimated 1,583,463 tons for week four compared to the 3 year average of 1,608,400 tons.








Below is a list of January USDA estimates versus final production for California processed tomatoes. The 2024 crop was initially 11.6 million tons but was revised to 11.5 in May. California has fallen below their January estimate 6 out of 8 times.
